



**C**ellist Jen Mulhern has been performing in the Central Texas area for the past twelve years as both a classical and improvisational artist. Born and raised in San Antonio, TX, she began playing the cello at age 11 and was instantly hooked! She received her Bachelor's degree in Music Performance from Texas State University-San Marcos after performing in Scotland, England, Canada and the United States with the Texas State Symphony Orchestra as principal cellist. Ms. Mulhern's versatile style has also earned her recording and performance opportunities with Michael Buble, Marco Antonio Solis, Edgar Meyer, award-winning multicultural ensemble Salsa Del Rio, R&B/Soul singer Lauren Silva, pop/electronic band Matson Belle, Trio Los Vigilantes, Color of Sound, and countless other singers, songwriters and ensembles. In addition to her collaborations with these unique musical groups, Ms. Mulhern has been a guest performer at the International Society for Improvising Musicians (ISIM) Conference, South By Southwest, and the Notre Dame Jazz Festival. She currently performs with the Victoria Symphony and is principal cellist of the Laredo Philharmonic.
