



Sarah Marie Perkins, Danish-American violist-violinist, began playing the violin at age 6 and switched to viola age 12. Ms. Perkins made her orchestral debut at the age of 15 when she was chosen to perform as a member of the London Symphony at the Florida International Festival in 1999. Since then, she has been privileged to perform multiple times at Carnegie Hall, and concertized around the world. While on the December 2010 World Orchestra tour, Ms. Perkins received a Musician of Peace Award from the Cultural Foundation of Peace at the International Human Rights Forum in Santiago de Compostela, Spain.

Recent musical engagements, on both violin and viola, include performances with the: Houston Latin American Philharmonic, Houston Young Artist Collective, Lake Charles Symphony, Louisiana Philharmonic, Mercury Orchestra, Shreveport Symphony and Victoria Symphony.
